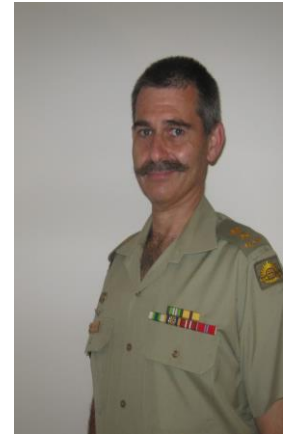

Saturday 19th October 2019

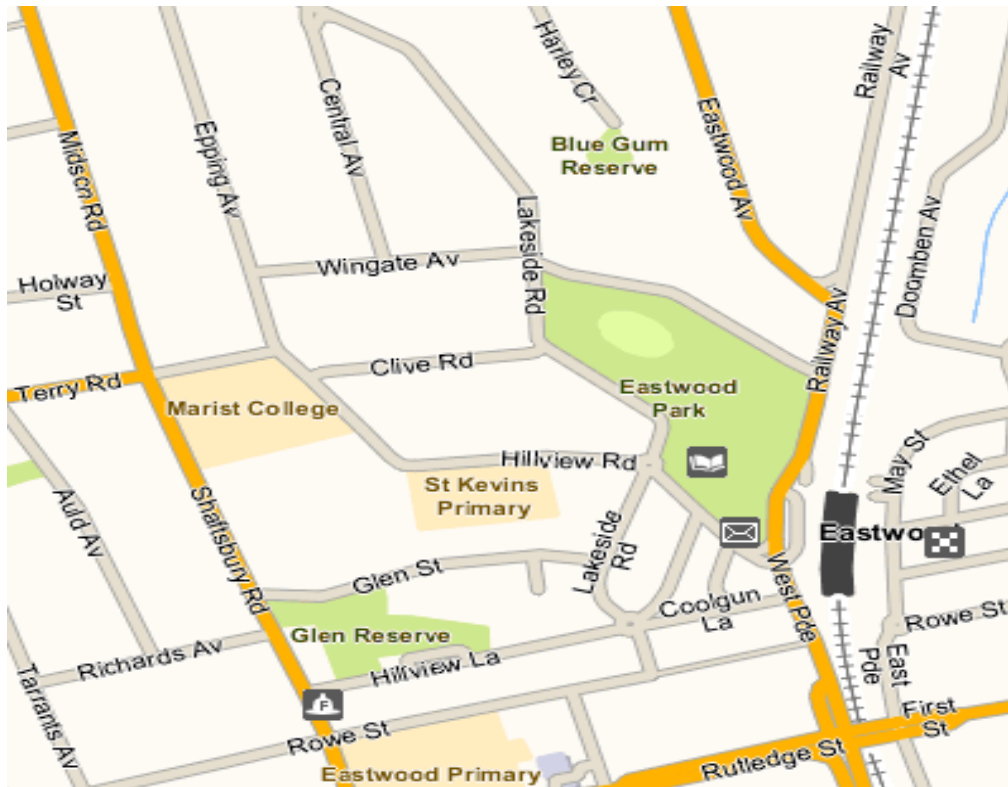
