1.0 GENERAL INFORMATION

- 1.1 Members of the New South Wales Group are invited to attend the Annual Group Recreation Camp.
- 1.2 The camp will be held at Castle Mountain, Webb's Creek, Wisemans Ferry.
- 1.3 This Camp will be conducted over the weekend of 3rd April to 5th April 2020.

2.0 ARRIVAL AND PICKUP TIMES

- 2.1 Members are required to enter the camp for registration on Friday evening no later than 2000HRS (8:00PM).
- 2.2 On arrival, all members are to report to the Camp Accommodation Officer for registration in the main dining hall.
- 2.3 The program will conclude at 1500hrs (3:00PM) on Sunday. Members can be picked up from this time.

3.0 ATTENDANCE

- 3.1 This recreation camp is open to all members of NSW Group regardless of age and gender.
- 3.2 **All adults, regardless of membership (ie: Parents / Carers) are to have a valid Working with Children Check in order to attend this camp. No WWC = No Camp.**

4.0 TRANSPORT, ACCOMODATION AND MEALS

- 4.1 Transport to and from the Camp remains the responsibility of individual members and squadrons.
- 4.2 Members attending the Camp will sleep in a-frame, air-conditioned tent style accommodation.
- 4.3 Members will need to bring sleeping bags and pillows.
- 4.4 Meals will be catered for throughout the weekend, commencing from Saturday with breakfast, concluding with lunch on Sunday.
- 4.5 It is the responsibility of all members to ensure that they have dinner on the Friday before entering camp.
- 4.6 Due to expected traffic using the ferry; transport to and from the camp may be delayed. Please account for this when estimating travel time.

5.0 COST + PAYMENT

- 5.1 The cost for the weekend is \$120 per person and includes accommodation and meals.
- 5.2 Squadrons may collect payments for the camp. Please check with your Squadron O.C.
- 5.3 Payment for the camp can also be made direct to NSW Group online by going to nsw.airleague.com.au/rec2020
- 5.4 A Canteen will be available throughout the camp. All money raised will go to the Air League. Its suggested that members do not bring any more than \$30 in cash.

7.0 ACTIVITIES

- 7.1 Activities during the weekend include; Swimming, Canoeing, Flying Fox, Archery, Ball Games, Cricket, Football, Volleyball, Bush Walking, Tug - O - War, Raft building and Race, Games Obstacle Course, and Flying Kite competition.
- 7.2 Members may also bring remote controlled cars, helicopters, planes, etc. Kites can also be brought to enter into the kite flying competition conducted over the weekend.

8.0 WHAT TO PACK

- 8.1 Members should take the following items into camp:

Sleeping Bag or Blanket	Towel (Swimming)	Jumper / Jacket	Insect Repellent
Sleepwear	Towel (Showers)	Torch (Important)	Sun Cream
Wet weather gear	Toiletries	Camp Dress (optional)	Footwear (no thongs)

- 8.2 All personal items should be marked clearly for identification purposes.
- 8.3 Please consider sun safety for swimmers (eg: Rash Shirts, Swim Hats, 1 piece (girls), etc).
- 8.4 Members are asked not to pack excessive amounts of snacks / lollies. A Canteen will be available on site.

9.0 IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- 9.1 **The camp application form (17a) must be completed and handed to the accommodation officer upon entry to the camp. No form = no camp.**
- 9.2 In a medical emergency, members will be conveyed to the nearest Public Hospital, in this case it would be Hawkesbury District Hospital (Waindson 2756).
- 9.3 All members are reminded that communication coverage is extremely limited at this location and mobile phones may not work as result.
- 9.4 As this is a recreation camp NO Air League uniform is required; Officers need to take their Australian Air League cap and or baseball cap.
