1.0 AIM

- 1.1 To hold a camp to improve the standard of drill, band, leadership, administration, methods of instruction and other subjects designed to raise efficiency of Squadrons and Wings within the NSW Group.
- 1.2 The camp will be held at Galston Gorge Conference Centre, 8 Crusader Rd, Galston NSW 2159.
- 1.3 This Camp will be conducted over the weekend 5th to 7th August 2022.

2.0 ARRIVAL AND PICKUP TIMES

- 2.1 Members are required to enter the camp, in full Air League Uniform, for registration on Friday evening no later than 2000HRS (8:00PM).
- 2.2 On arrival, all members are to report to the Camp Accommodation Officer for registration, accommodation and flight allocations. Full uniform inspections of all Officers and NCO's will take place after registration.
- 2.3 The official opening ceremony is scheduled to commence at 2100HRS (9:00PM).
- 2.4 The march out parade is scheduled for 1500HRS (3:00PM) on Sunday with dismissal being at 1600HRS (4:00PM). Parents and friends are welcome to attend. The venue must be vacated no later than 1700HRS (5:00PM).

3.0 ATTENDANCE

- 3.1 This Training Camp is open to all Officers, potential Officers, NCOs, potential NCOs, and band members of the New South Wales Group. Networking is an important part of our organisation this is your opportunity to network with other members, receive updates on Air League information and build new friendships.
- 3.2 All Warrant Officers are required to attend as it is a part of your Officer Development Training.
- 3.3 All Group, Wing, Squadron Officers and NCOs are reminded that they all should attend the Group's Annual Training Camp once every two years. For those who have not attended within this time frame are required to attend this year's training camp.

4.0 TRANSPORT, ACCOMODATION AND MEALS

- 4.1 Transport to and from the Camp remains the responsibility of individual members and Squadrons.
- 4.2 Members attending the Camp will have cabin style accommodation.
- 4.3 Meals will be catered for throughout the weekend, commencing from Friday with supper, concluding with lunch on Sunday.

5.0 COST + PAYMENT

- 5.1 The cost for the weekend is \$150 per person and includes accommodation and meals. A generous Corporate sponsor who wishes to remain anonymous at this time will be subsiding the camp by \$40 per attendee.
- 5.2 Due to ongoing COVID supply constraints, linen will not be available.
- 5.3 Officers attending for only one day and who require a meal will incur a cost of \$80. Members wishing to attend for only a day must seek approval from the Group Executive Commissioner.
- 5.4 There is no additional surcharge for special dietary requirements.

- 7.2 All personal items should be marked clearly for identification purposes.
- 7.3 Members are asked not to pack snacks, lollies, or food of any kind.
