



## **1.0 Intention**

- 1.1 Members of NSW Group have been invited again to the ANAZC Day Sydney City Parade, to be conducted on Thursday 25<sup>th</sup> April 2024.
- 1.2 As many members as possible are requested to attend.

## **2.0 General**

- 2.1 Full AAL Uniform and Ribbons (not Medals) are to be worn. Any member without the correct uniform will not be permitted to participate (as per Section 18 of the Manual).
- 2.2 Members are also reminded that when traveling to and from the parade full and correct uniform is also to be worn – that means ties are correctly done up, correct shoes, etc.
- 2.3 Squadrons are permitted to attend their local parades if held on the same day, otherwise all Sydney-based squadrons are expected to provide as many members as possible to the city parade.

## **3.0 Main Parade**

- 3.1 Members are to assemble at 0800 hours at the corner of Castlereagh St and Martin Place. **(Refer to map on section 8.1)**
- 3.2 From this point members will be directed to banner-carrying duties.
- 3.3 No member is to form up at any other location.

## **4.0 AAL Wreath Laying Parade**

- 4.1 At the conclusion of the main parade (approx. 1230 hours), members will assemble in Pitt St (Near Hunter St), with the Group Flag Party, massed Band, and Flights under the direction of the NSW Group Field Commissioner.
- 4.2 At 1300 hrs the parade will move off, and turn right into Martin Place, upon which an eyes right will be given when passing the Cenotaph.
- 4.3 The parade will Halt and turn into line to face the Cenotaph. A wreath-laying ceremony will take place followed by the playing of the Last Post and Reveille.
- 4.4 At the playing of the Last Post, all officers (excluding Warrant Officers) will salute, and the Group Flag will salute. Officers are to cease saluting at the end of the Last Post. At the playing of Reveille, the Group Flag will be raised.
- 4.5 Following the wreath-laying ceremony and at the direction of the Group Field Commissioner, the parade will move into a column of route, and march off across George St and into Barrack St where the parade will halt and be dismissed. **(Refer to map on section 8.2)**



## 5.0 Community Awareness Award Hours

- 5.1 Members who attend the full day from 0800 hours to 1330 hours will be eligible for 5.5 hours towards their Community Awareness award.

## 6.0 Form 17a

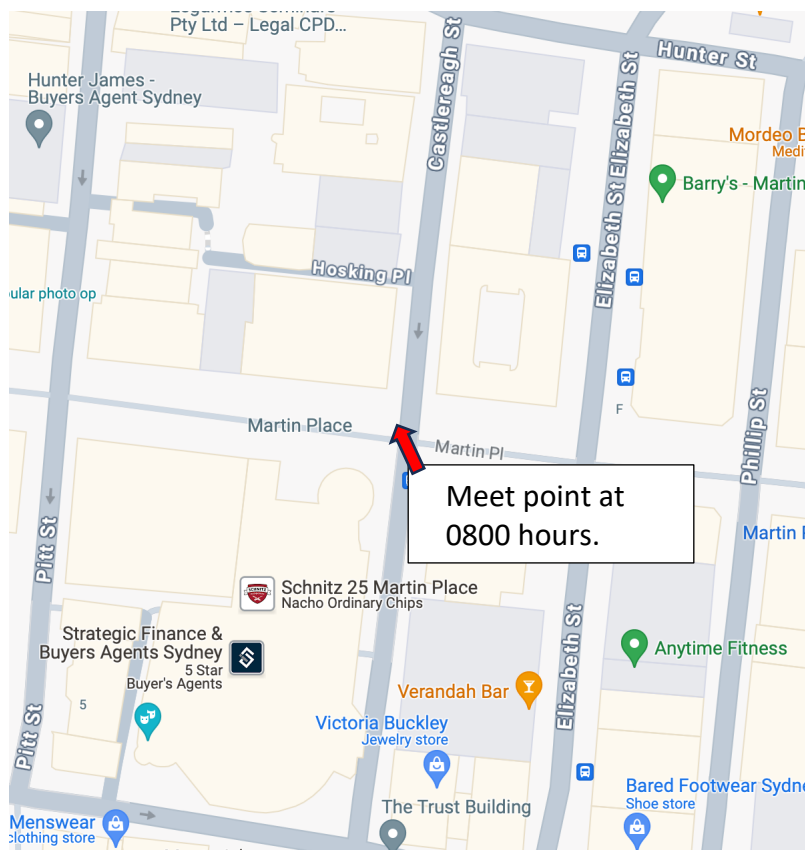

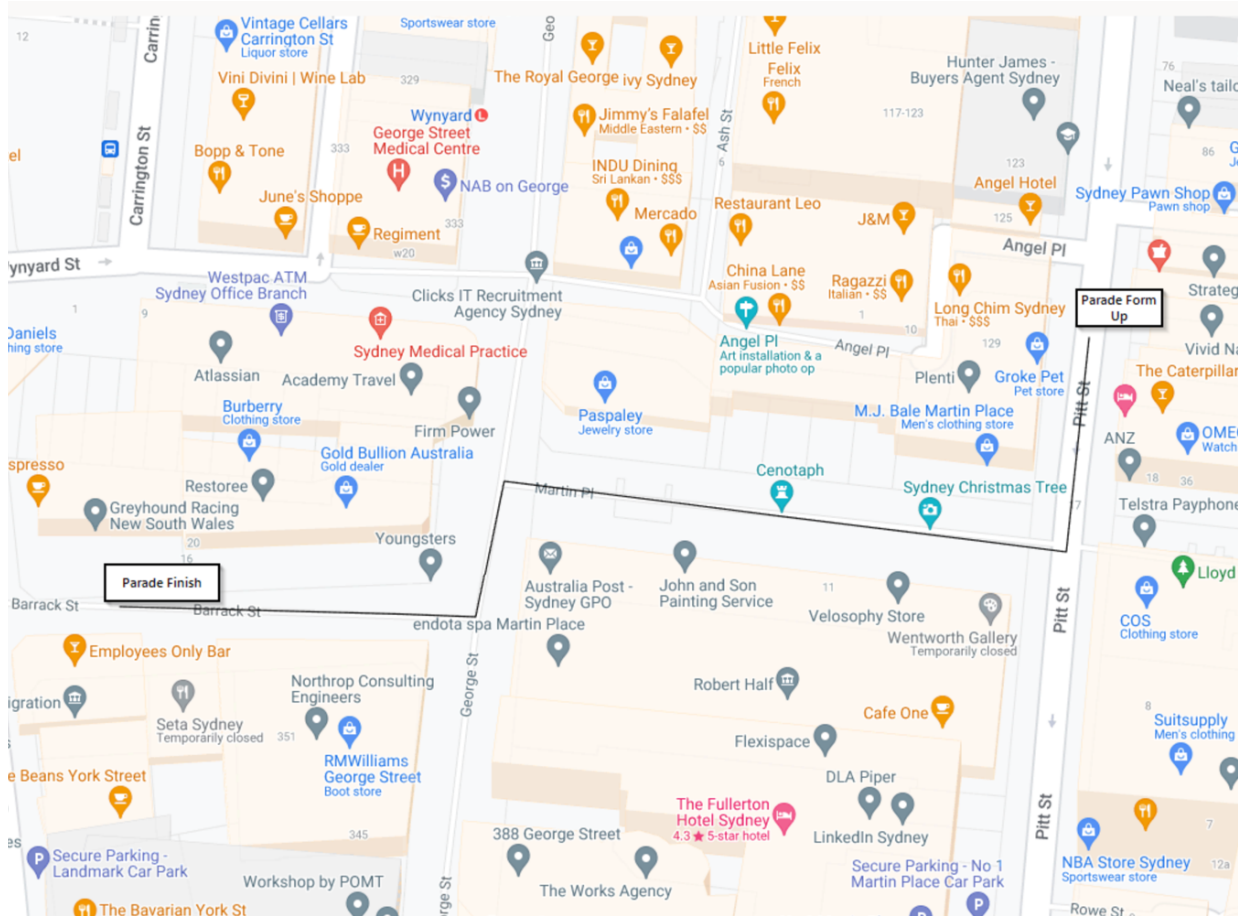
